

Aylesford Newsprint's Paper what we require...

Yes please

The rule is **white paper** including:

- Newspapers
- Magazines
- White office and printer paper
- Junk mail
- Shredded paper (no plastic bags please!)
- White envelopes (even those with plastic windows)
- Brochures
- Directories including Yellow Pages (they are now printed on white paper)



No thanks

Please help us by removing contaminants from the paper, in order of priority we do not want:

1. Glass. **WHY NOT?** Glass can break down into sand particles which can damage essential equipment in our process.
2. Brown or grey cardboard (eg food packaging and toilet rolls coloured paper, card or paper bags. **WHY NOT?** We do not use any chemicals in the process to turn a brown or coloured fibre white. We only make white newsprint, therefore, we only want white fibres.
3. Plastic bottles, tin cans, textiles, plastic bags. **WHY NOT?** You cannot make paper from such items. They have to be removed by our pulpers and sent to landfill. **They should be recycled properly!**



Any material which has been in contact with greasy food or burnt paper will leave marks on our finished product and we do not want that.
